We have carried out a Covid-19 risk assessment and have taken steps to comply with the government Covid-19 guidance for Places of Worship. Here are a few things to help you stay safe.

- Please use the hand gel provided when you arrive, and when you leave the building.
- We have seats reserved especially for visitors, all safely distanced, someone will show you where these are.
- There are bibles and hymn books available for you which are quarantined for 48 hours after each service.
- We are not singing the hymns at the moment. They are announced and the organist plays the appropriate number of verses, but we stay seated and use these times for reflection and reading through the hymns to ourselves.
- At the end of the service we leave the building through the fire exit door at the front, next to the pulpit. The minister leaves first, then we leave row by row from the front staying seated until it is our turn, and remembering to keep a 2m distance.

We are very pleased to have you with us and hope you feel welcome. Sorry for the formality but we want to do our very best to help keep one another safe.
